- Do not laminate over staples or paper clip.
- This machine uses laminating films only. This machine is used for laminating only.
- Do not remove the cover or dismantle the machine, no serviceable parts inside.

# CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Since deposits of residue will influence the effectiveness of laminating please clean the rollers periodically after use by inserting a folded letter size paper into the entrance of the laminator. Any residues will come out on the paper. Repeat this process several times to clean the rollers.




# **USER'S MANUAL** LAMINATOR

Model: 50325

### PACKAGE CONTENTS

### USING YOUR LAMINATOR

This laminator is operated by switch (ON/OFF) located at the front side of the appliance.

- Plug the machine into outlet.
- Turn the switch to **ON** position, the RED power LED will light up, the machine will start to heat up. After 3-5 minutes, the Green READY LED will illuminate when the machine has reached the operating temperature. The machine is ready to laminate.
- Insert the document into the correct pouch size. Leave approximately 3 to 5mm each side of the pouch. It's highly recommended NOT to put several smaller documents into a large pouch. This may cause poor laminating effects and pouch jams.
- Insert the pouch evenly, with the closed end first, into the laminator entrance until it engages with the rollers. Do not use pouches thicker than 125mik and never insert a pouch open edge first into the machine.
- The pouch will move through the machine and exit at the rear. The laminated documents exiting the machine may still be hot, so precautions are required while handing.
- Turn the laminator **OFF** after use and remove the plug from power supply.

NOTE: Do not insert the open side of the pouch into the laminator.

# IAM RELEASE

1. The machine is equipped with a JAM RELEASE button to clear document jams, which is located at the back of the machine.

# 2. Symptoms of Paper Jams:

- Documents fail to exit
- Abnormal noises are heard during operation
- Document become wrinkled on its way through the machine.

**3.** Once document jams occur, **turn OFF** the machine immediately, push and hold the **JAM RELEASE** button and pull out the document by hand.

### TROUBLE SHOOTING

**WARNING:** Do not attempt to repair the machine. This will void the product warranty. If you have a problem, contact the manufacturer's service.

- 1. No power, indicators do not light up and / or no operation
- Ensure the machine is correctly plugged in and the power switch is turned to ON position. If the machine is still not working, call for repair.

### 2. Document Jams

- Verify the correct pouch thickness as specified (80-125mik) used. Ensure that the document is inserted evenly into the machine. Follow the instructions in "Jam Release" section to clear the jam.
- 3. Mat laminates or pouch does not completely seal the document
- Pass through laminator again, which will help to improve the quality.
- 4. Wait longer time (more than 5 minutes) to warm up the machine.
- Warm up time may take longer than 5 minutes depending on the room temperature.
- It will take 3-5 minutes to warm up the machine at room temperature 25-28 °C. The Green READY LED indicator will illuminate when the machine has reached the operating temperature.
- If the room temperature is lower than 25°C, the machine may take approximately 5-7 minutes to warm up.

# WARNING: IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not place fingers, hair, loose clothing and jewelry near the paper feed slot as serious injury may occur.
- The top of the laminator will become hot during use please do not touch.
- Please keep the machine away from children and pets.
- Make sure the on /off switch is on the **OFF** position before plugging in the laminator.
- Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the product.
- Please note cardboard carrier pouches must not be used with this laminator as it may cause jamming or damage to the laminator
- Unplug the laminator when not in use or before moving or cleaning.
- Only clean the Laminator by wiping with a dry cloth.
- Do not place the machine near to any heat source or in a damp environment.
- If the power supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified electrician to avoid a hazard.
