Introduction

Thank you for choosing our Smart Wi-Fi Socket. Please read this manual before use to ensure you get the most out of your device.

About the product

A smart Wi-Fi socket that allows you to conveniently control electrical appliances via a mobile app. Thanks to Wi-Fi connectivity and integration with the Tuya Smart / Smart Life system, it enables you to remotely manage the operation of appliances in your home or office – from anywhere and at any time.

The device supports voice control via popular assistants such as Amazon Alexa and Google Home, making it even more convenient to manage your home automation. The scheduling and timer functions allow you to automatically switch connected devices on or off according to a set schedule.

The socket also offers real-time operational status monitoring, so you can check at any time whether a particular device is active. The device sharing system allows you to share access with other household members, enabling simultaneous control from multiple accounts.

Safety instructions

To ensure the safe and correct use of the device, please observe the following guidelines:

- 1) Use the device solely for its intended purpose and in accordance with its technical specifications.
- 2) Do not exceed the maximum permissible load for the socket.
- 3) The device is intended for indoor use only.
- 4) Do not use the device in areas exposed to damp, water or high temperatures.
- 5) Do not dismantle or modify the device yourself.
- 6) If the device is damaged, stop using it immediately.
- 7) During installation, ensure that the power socket is in good working order and correctly earthed.
- 8) Keep the device out of the reach of children.

Connecting the device to the mobile app

1. Scan the QR code below and download the app (Figure 1 in the appendix)

The Smart Life/Tuya Smart apps are available on the App Store and Google Play.

2. Add the device to the app.

- 1) Open the app and tap 'Add Device' or the '+' icon in the top right-hand corner of the screen.
- 2) Select the Socket (Wi-Fi) category from the list of electrical devices.
- 3) Make sure the LED on the socket is flashing rapidly. If not, press and hold the button on the socket for a few seconds until the LED starts flashing rapidly.
- 4) In the app, confirm that the LED is flashing rapidly.
- 5) Enter your home Wi-Fi network password.
- 6) Wait until the connection process is complete, then tap OK.

Note: If the device status in the app shows as 'Offline', please wait about 1 minute for the socket to connect to the router and server. If the LED is lit but the device still appears as 'Offline', close the app and restart it.

App features

1. Remote control

You can switch the device on and off directly in the app by tapping the device icon. The device's status is displayed in real time.

2. Device Sharing

You can share control of the device with other Smart Life app users. Note: The person you wish to share the device with must be logged into the Smart Life app; otherwise, they will not receive an invitation.

3. Voice control

The device supports voice control via smart home systems such as Amazon Alexa and Google Home. Detailed configuration instructions can be found in the app's settings. For voice control to work, you'll need: an active Wi-Fi connection,

internet access, a Tuya/Smart Life app account, and a configured voice assistant.

The process works as follows:

- 1) The switch connects to your home Wi-Fi network and is added to the Tuya Smart or Smart Life app.
- 2) Your Tuya/Smart Life account connects to Google Assistant or Amazon Alexa.
- 3) The user gives the device a name, e.g. 'Living room light'.
- 4) When a command is spoken, e.g. "Turn on the living room light", the voice assistant sends the command via the internet to the Tuya system, and then to the switch.

4. Monitoring electricity consumption

Maintenance

Disconnect the device from the mains before cleaning. Clean the casing only with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth. Do not use chemicals, solvents or abrasive materials, as these may damage the surface of the device.

Do not dispose of the end-of-life device with household waste. The product must be taken to an appropriate collection point for waste electrical and electronic equipment in accordance with applicable environmental regulations.

Warranty

The product is covered by the manufacturer's warranty. The warranty covers defects resulting from manufacturing or material faults that become apparent during the normal use of the device . The warranty does not cover damage resulting from improper use, unauthorised modifications to the device or mechanical damage.
