SAFETY WARNINGS

RFID PROXIMITY CARDS FOR EV CHARGING STATIONS

The following list of safety warnings has been drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2023/988 on general product safety (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the improper use of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable manner so that they are accessible to a wide audience, including older people and those with reduced mobility.

The RFID contactless cards offered by NTEC sp. z o.o. bear the CE mark, which certifies their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use RFID cards for their intended purpose and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. Mechanical risks:

- Damage to the card (breaking, scratching, delamination) may prevent it from functioning properly.
- Do not bend the card or subject it to excessive pressure.

2. Environmental risks:

- Exposure to high temperatures, moisture or direct sunlight may affect the card's durability.
- Contact with chemicals may damage the card's surface or structure.

3. Usage risks:

- The card does not contain any electrical components requiring a power supply, but improper use may result in loss of functionality.
- Do not use a damaged card – it may not be read correctly by the charging station.

SPECIFIC RISKS ARISING FROM USE

4. Compatibility risks:

- Ensure that the card is compatible with the RFID system used in the EV charging station.
- Using an incompatible card may result in a lack of access to the device.

5. Risk of loss or unauthorised use:

- Losing the card may allow unauthorised persons access to the charging station.
- If the card is lost, it must be deactivated immediately (if the system allows this).

6. Risk of operational disruption:

- Storing the card near strong electromagnetic fields may affect its operation.
- Placing the card near metal objects may make it difficult to read.

7. Risks associated with improper use:

- Keep the charger out of reach of children and pets. Do not use the card for any purpose other than authorising access to the charging station.
- Do not tamper with the card's structure (e.g. do not drill into or cut it).

PRECAUTIONS DURING MAINTENANCE

8. Cleaning:

- The card should be cleaned with a dry or slightly damp, soft cloth.
- Do not use aggressive chemicals or solvents.

9. Condition check:

- Check the condition of the card regularly – if damaged, it must be replaced.

10. Storage:

- Store the card in a dry place, away from moisture and heat sources.
- Avoid storing in wallets that are subject to bending or crushing.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

11. Child safety:

- The card is not a toy – keep out of reach of children.

12. Avoid modifications:

- Do not attempt to modify or repair the card yourself.

13. Use:

- Use the card in accordance with the EV charging station user manual.

14. What to do in the event of a fault:

- If you experience problems reading the card, use a different card or contact the system operator.
- If you notice any irregularities, contact the manufacturer or the service department.

IMPORTANCE OF FOLLOWING WARNINGS

Following the above warnings minimises the risk of personal injury, equipment failure and material loss. Ignoring these recommendations may lead to serious health and material risks. Ensure your own safety and that of your loved ones by observing the recommended precautions.

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
