SAFETY WARNINGS

SMARTPHONE SERVICE TOOLS

The following list of safety warnings has been drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2023/988 on general product safety (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the improper use of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable manner so that they are accessible to a wide audience, including older people and those with reduced mobility.

The smartphone service tools offered by NTEC sp. z o.o. bear the CE mark, which certifies their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use smartphone service tools in accordance with their intended purpose and the manufacturer's instructions.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. ☐ Mechanical risks:

- Working with sharp tools, such as knives, tweezers or screwdrivers, can lead to serious cuts, particularly in the absence of appropriate protective equipment, such as gloves.
- Improper use of tools, e.g. applying excessive force to components, may result in damage to the components being repaired, such as casings, connectors or delicate integrated circuits.

2. ☐ Risks associated with pressure:

- Excessive pressure when using tools such as crimping tools or pliers can cause components to be crushed or deformed, rendering them unusable.
- Conversely, insufficient pressure may lead to loose connections, which can be a source of subsequent faults, such as problems with electrical conductivity.

SPECIFIC RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH USE

3. ☐ Compatibility risks:

- Tools must be precisely matched to the type and size of components, such as screws or connectors, to avoid damaging them. Using unsuitable tools may lead to permanent damage to the device.
- The use of low-quality tools or parts may affect the effectiveness of the repair and increase the risk of a recurrence of the fault.

4. ☐ Risks associated with environmental conditions:

- Working in extreme conditions, such as high humidity, low or high temperatures, can negatively affect the durability of tools and the accuracy of their operation.
- Contact between tools and water, chemicals or dust may lead to corrosion, which reduces their service life and precision.

PRECAUTIONS DURING MAINTENANCE

5. ☐ Maintenance:

- Regular cleaning of tools, particularly moving parts such as crimping tools or pliers, prevents them from seizing up and extends their service life. Failure to lubricate or clean them may result in rapid wear or damage.
- Neglecting tool maintenance can lead to malfunction, which increases the risk of damage to the equipment being repaired.

6. ☐ Storage:

- Tools should be stored in a dry, clean place, preferably in dedicated cases or organisers, to protect them from mechanical damage and the loss of small parts.
- Extreme temperatures, e.g. in uninsulated garages or cars, can weaken the materials from which the tools are made, which will negatively affect their durability and safety in use.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

7. Child safety:

- Tools, particularly those that are sharp or contain small parts, must be stored out of the reach of children, as they may accidentally cut themselves, choke on small parts or damage the tools.
- The lack of appropriate safety measures, such as a lockable case, increases the risk of children accidentally coming into contact with the tools.

8. Avoid modifications:

- Do not attempt to modify or repair the product yourself. If you encounter any problems, contact the manufacturer or their authorised service centre.

9. What to do in the event of a fault:

- If the device exhibits abnormal behaviour, such as unusual appearance, odour or sounds, contact the service centre.
- If you observe any dangerous behaviour of the product, contact the manufacturer immediately.

IMPORTANCE OF FOLLOWING THE WARNINGS

Following the above warnings minimises the risk of personal injury, equipment failure and property damage. Ignoring these recommendations may lead to serious health and property risks. Ensure your own safety and that of your loved ones by observing the recommended precautions.
