SAFETY WARNINGS

BARCODE SCANNER STANDS

The following list of safety warnings has been drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2023/988 on general product safety (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the improper use of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable manner so that they are accessible to a wide audience, including older people and those with reduced mobility.

The barcode scanner stands offered by NTEC sp. z o.o. are CE-marked, which confirms their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use the stand in accordance with its intended purpose and the manufacturer's instructions.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. Mechanical risk:

- Incorrect positioning of the stand may cause it to tip over and damage the scanner.
- Overloading the stand may cause deformation or breakage of structural components.

2. Stability risks:

- Placing the stand on an uneven or slippery surface may cause it to shift or tip over.
- A lack of adequate ballast or securing may affect stability during use.

3. Usage risk:

- Incorrect placement of the scanner in the holder may cause it to fall out.
- Incorrect adjustment of the holder's angle may hinder operation and increase the risk of damage to the equipment.

SPECIFIC RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH USE

4. ☐ Risk of damage to the device:

- If the scanner falls from a height, it may be permanently damaged.
- If the stand does not fit the scanner model, the device may be unstable.

5. ☐ Trip hazard:

- Cables connected to the scanner may pose a tripping hazard, particularly in high-traffic areas.

6. ☐ Risks associated with improper use:

- Using the stand to support other objects may damage it.
- Improper use may shorten the product's lifespan.

PRECAUTIONS DURING MAINTENANCE

7. ☐ Cleaning:

- The stand should be cleaned with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
- Do not use aggressive chemicals or solvents.

8. ☐ Condition check:

- Regularly check the condition of the structural components and the stability of the stand.
- If any damage is noticed, stop using the stand.

9. ☐ Storage:

- Store in a dry place, away from moisture and heat sources.
- Avoid locations prone to mechanical damage.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

10. Danger to children:

- This product is not a toy – keep out of reach of children.
- Children may unintentionally damage the handle, which could increase the risk of it failing during use.

11. Avoid modifications:

- Do not attempt to modify or repair the mount yourself. If you encounter any problems, contact the manufacturer or their authorised service centre.
- Place the stand on a stable, level surface before use.

12. What to do in the event of a fault:

- If the product is damaged or loses stability, stop using it immediately.
- If necessary, contact the manufacturer or a service centre.
