SAFETY WARNINGS REGARDING THE USE OF WIRELESS TRANSMITTERS AND BLUETOOTH AUDIO ADAPTERS

The following list of safety warnings has been drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2023/988 on general product safety (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the improper use of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable manner to ensure they are accessible to a wide audience, including older people and those with reduced mobility.

The wireless Bluetooth audio transmitters and adapters offered by NTEC sp. z o.o. bear the CE mark, which certifies their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use Bluetooth audio transmitters and adapters in accordance with their intended purpose and the manufacturer's instructions.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. Electrical risks:

- Only connect the device to a power source that complies with its technical specifications.
- If the device is powered via a USB port, use fully functional USB ports, chargers or power adapters with the appropriate specifications.
- Do not expose the device to water, moisture or liquids, as this may lead to a short circuit, damage to the product or electric shock.

2. Risk of overheating:

- Do not place the product near heat sources such as radiators, hot air vents, cookers, fireplaces or devices emitting high temperatures.
- Exposure to moisture or extreme temperatures may cause the device to malfunction.
- Do not leave the device in a place exposed to direct sunlight, particularly in a car.

3. Risk of incorrect connection:

- Before connecting, ensure that the selected connector, e.g. 3.5 mm AUX, RCA, USB or other, is compatible with the device to which the transmitter or adapter is being connected.
- Do not use force when connecting plugs and cables.
- Do not connect cables to unsuitable sockets, as this may damage the connector, the audio device or the adapter itself.
- Before first use, read the user manual for both the source device and the receiving device.

SPECIFIC RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH USE

4. When using at home:

- Incorrect connection of the adapter to the USB port may result in damage or failure.
- Do not use the product near bathtubs, washbasins, sinks, swimming pools or other areas with high humidity.

5. Signal quality management:

- Signal interference caused by other wireless devices (e.g. microwaves, DECT phones) may reduce connection quality.
- The range of the Wi-Fi adapter may be limited by physical obstacles such as walls, furniture or metal surfaces.

6. When using in a car:

- Install and connect the device in a way that does not obstruct the driver's view, access to vehicle controls or the operation of safety systems.
- Do not operate the device whilst driving if it could distract you from the road.

- Carry out settings, Bluetooth pairing and cable changes before setting off or after stopping the vehicle in a safe place.
 - Do not leave the device or cables loose in a position where they could interfere with driving, the operation of the pedals, the gearbox or the steering wheel.
- 7. Risks associated with Bluetooth and NFC technology:**
- Use Bluetooth and NFC functions in accordance with the device's user manual.
 - Do not attempt to connect the device to unknown or untrusted devices.
 - In places where the use of wireless devices is prohibited or restricted, e.g. in medical facilities, on aircraft or in areas marked as no-radio zones, follow local rules and staff instructions.
 - A device using wireless communication may be susceptible to radio interference or may itself cause interference with other electronic devices.
- 8. Risks associated with volume levels:**
- Before playback begins, set the volume to a low level on both the source and receiving devices.
 - Excessively high volume levels may cause hearing damage or damage to the speakers.
 - Do not use headphones at high volume for long periods.
 - In a car, set the volume to a level that allows you to hear warning signals from your surroundings.
- 9. Risk of damage to cables and connectors:**
- Regularly check the condition of the AUX, RCA and USB cables, plugs and the device casing.
 - Do not use the product if the cables are frayed, cracked, broken, melted or visibly damaged.
 - Do not bend the cables at sharp angles and do not pull on the cable when disconnecting it.
 - When disconnecting a cable, hold the plug, not the cable.
 - Do not use excessive force when connecting or disconnecting connectors.

PRECAUTIONS DURING MAINTENANCE

10. Cleaning:

- Before cleaning, disconnect the device from the mains and from any connected audio equipment.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, solvents, alcohol, petrol or abrasive materials.
- Do not immerse the unit in water or spray it with liquid.
- Before reconnecting, ensure that the unit and connectors are completely dry.

11. Condition check:

- Check regularly that the device, connectors, cables and casing are not damaged.
- Do not use the device if it has been exposed to water, dropped from a height or is not working properly.
- If you notice any damage, stop using the product.

12. Storage:

- Store the device in a dry, clean place, away from moisture, dust, heat sources and direct sunlight.

13. Child safety:

- This product is not a toy and should not be used by children without adult supervision.

14. Avoid modifications:

- Do not tamper with the product's construction, cables, connectors, electronic circuitry or Bluetooth/NFC module.

15. What to do in the event of a fault:

- If the product exhibits any abnormal behaviour, such as an unusual smell, appearance or sounds, stop using it immediately and contact customer service.
- If you observe any dangerous behaviour of the product, contact the manufacturer immediately.
