SAFETY WARNINGS FOR USE ADAPTERS AND ADAPTERS

The following list of safety warnings has been compiled in accordance with the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the misuse of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable way to be accessible to a wide audience, including the elderly and people with reduced mobility.

The adapters and adapters on offer from the manufacturer NTEC sp. z o.o. are CE certified, which proves their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use adapters and adapters according to their intended use and manufacturer's recommendations.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

- 1. Electrical risk:**
 - Use adapters and adapters suitable for the voltage and current to prevent short circuits or overheating.
 - Do not use products with visible damage, such as abrasions, cracks in the housing or loose connectors.
- 2. Mechanical risks:**
 - Check that adapters and adapters are properly connected to avoid accidental disconnection or damage to the device ports.
 - Do not use excessive force when connecting or disconnecting adapters to avoid damaging the connectors.
- 3. Risk of overheating:**
 - Do not use adapters in cramped, poorly ventilated areas, especially high-powered devices.
 - Avoid prolonged, continuous use of adapters or adapters that are not designed for intensive use.

SPECIFIC HAZARDS ARISING FROM USE

- 4. During installation:**
 - Make sure the adapter or adaptor is compatible with your device and its port (e.g. HDMI, USB-C, VGA, RJ45).
 - Verify that the adapter meets the required transmission standards, such as supported video resolution, data transfer speed or charging power.
- 5. Compatibility risks:**
 - For advanced applications such as 4K video streaming or fast charging, make sure the adapter meets the technical requirements of your device.
- 6. Signal interference:**
 - Limit the number of adapters per connection to avoid a drop in transmission quality.

MAINTENANCE PRECAUTIONS

- 7. Cleaning:**
 - Regularly clean the adaptor connectors with a dry, soft cloth to remove dust and dirt, remembering to disconnect the adaptor from the equipment before cleaning.
 - Avoid using wet cloths and chemicals that can damage electronic components.
- 8. Status check:**
 - Regularly check adapters and adapters for mechanical damage, such as loose connectors or cracks in the housing.

- If damage is detected, replace the product with a new one to avoid safety or performance problems.

9. Storage

- Store adapters and adapters in a dry, clean place, away from moisture, dust and heat sources.
- Use cases or organisers to protect them from loss or accidental damage.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

10. Child safety

- Keep adapters and adapters out of the reach of children to avoid accidental swallowing of small parts or misuse.

11. Avoid modifications

- Do not attempt to repair or modify the adapters yourself, as this may affect their safety and the quality of the connection.

12. Action in the event of an emergency:

- If the unit exhibits abnormal operation, such as overheating, sparking, unusual odour or noises, immediately switch it off and disconnect it from the power supply and then contact the service centre.
- If you observe any unsafe product behaviour, contact the manufacturer urgently.
