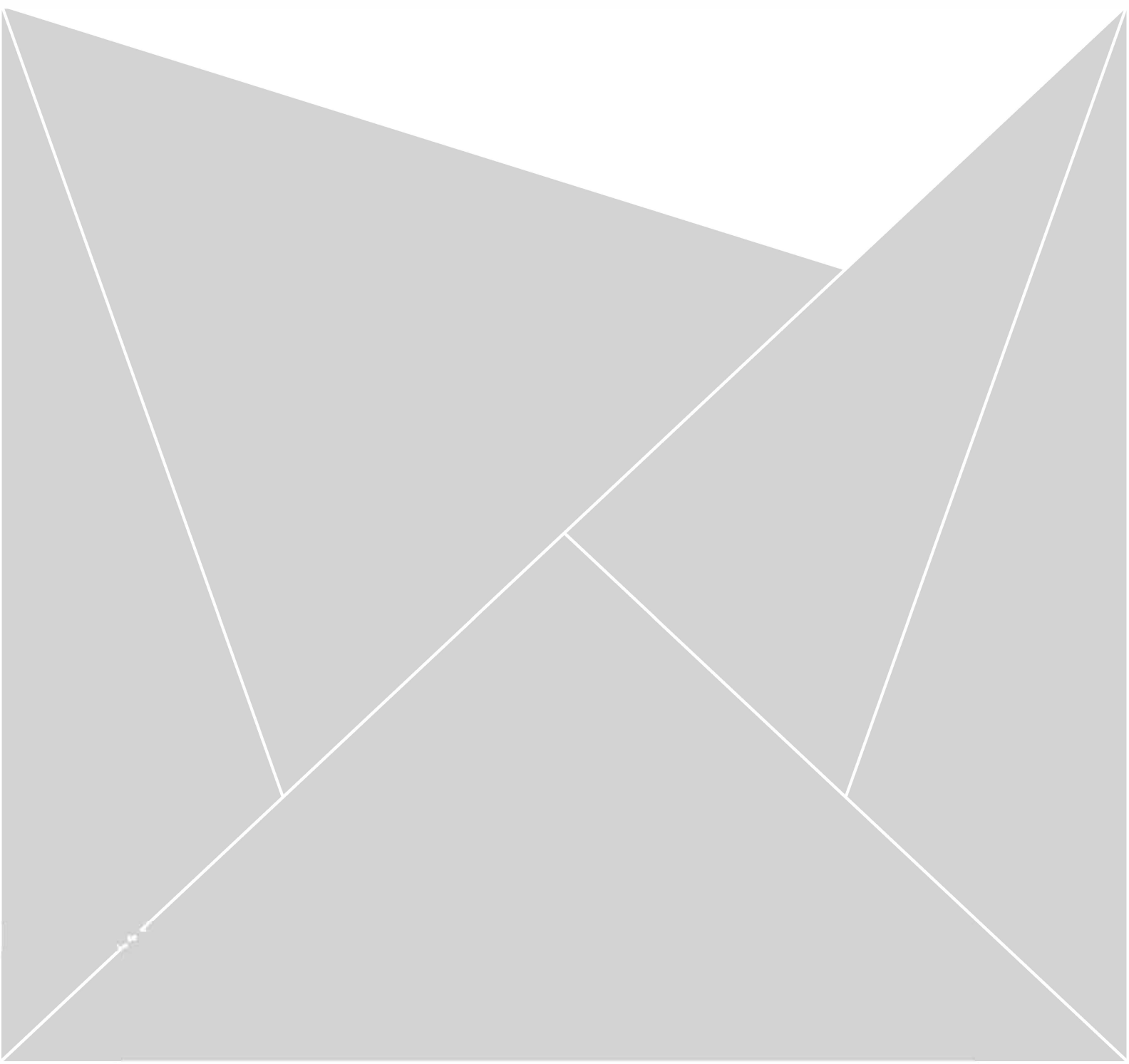

SAFETY WARNINGS FOR USE

Laser rangefinders

The following list of safety warnings has been compiled in accordance with the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the misuse of products. The warnings are worded in a simple and understandable way to be accessible to a wide audience, including the elderly and people with reduced mobility.

Laser rangefinders in the NTEC sp. z o.o. manufacturer's range are CE certified, which indicates their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use the products in accordance with their intended use and the manufacturer's recommendations.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. Electrical risks:

- The laser rangefinder is powered by a battery/battery - use only recommended power sources.
- Avoid contact of the device with water and moisture to prevent short circuits and electric shock.
- Do not open the case - the internal electrical components are not designed to be repaired by yourself.
- In the event of damage to the power cables or battery - discontinue use immediately.
- Only use batteries or voltage sources in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions (e.g. appropriate supply voltage).

2. Mechanical risks:

- Do not drop the device or subject it to strong shocks to avoid damage to the housing and measuring mechanisms.
- Avoid using the rangefinder in dusty environments or with particles that can enter the device.
- Do not use the device as an impact tool or structural support.

SPECIFIC HAZARDS ARISING FROM USE

3. Risk of damage during installation:

- When measuring, do not point the laser beam at reflective surfaces (mirrors, glass) to prevent the beam from reflecting into the eyes.
- Use the device only in accordance with the instructions - do not attempt to interfere with the factory settings of the laser system.
- Install batteries according to the polarity indicated in the compartment - improper installation may lead to damage to the unit.

MAINTENANCE PRECAUTIONS

4. Cleaning and maintenance:

- Regularly remove dust and dirt from the surface.
- Clean only with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth - no aggressive chemicals.
- Protect the measuring lenses from dirt, scratches and moisture.
- Do not use high-pressure compressed air, which can damage the optical components.
- Store the device in the original case, in a dry and clean place.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

5. Child safety:

- The device is not a toy - keep it out of the reach of children.
- Improper use of the laser by a child may lead to damage to the eyesight.

6. Additional precautions

- The rangefinder emits laser radiation according to the safety class indicated on the rating plate.
- Never point the laser beam towards the eyes of people or animals.
- Do not look directly into the beam or through optical instruments (binoculars, telescopes) to avoid the risk of damage to the retina.
- In the event of a malfunction of the laser system - discontinue use and contact an authorised service centre.

7. Avoid modifications:

- The manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from misuse, self-repair, modification of the device or failure to follow the instructions.

8. Action in case of malfunction:

- a. If the appliance exhibits malfunctions such as overheating, sparking, contact the manufacturer.

9. Disposal

- Used batteries and accumulators must not be disposed of in municipal waste - they must be taken to collection points according to local regulations.
- At the end of its service life, the device is subject to separate collection of electrical and electronic waste (crossed-out bin symbol).
- Do not disassemble the device on your own before disposal.

IMPORTANCE OF COMPLYING WITH WARNINGS

Adherence to the above warnings minimises the risk of personal injury, appliance failure and property damage. Ignoring the recommendations can lead to serious health and material risks. Keep yourself and your loved ones safe by observing the precautions indicated.
