SAFETY WARNINGS FOR USE VEHICLE CHARGERS

The following list of safety warnings has been compiled in accordance with the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the misuse of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable way to be accessible to a wide audience, including the elderly and people with reduced mobility.

The car chargers on offer from manufacturer NTEC sp. z o.o. are CE-certified, which proves their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use car chargers according to their intended use and the manufacturer's recommendations.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. Risk of electric shock:

- Only connect the charger to a working cigarette lighter socket in the car.
- Never touch the charger connectors with wet hands.

2. Risk of short circuit:

- Ensure that the charger contacts are clean and free of debris that can cause a short circuit.
- Do not use the charger in cigarette lighter sockets with visible damage.

3. Risk of overheating:

- Ensure good ventilation around the charger during use. Do not cover the device with materials that may prevent heat dissipation.
- Do not use the charger for long periods of time without interruption, especially in high ambient temperature conditions.

4. Fire risk:

- Do not use the charger if you notice smoke, unusual odours or excessive heat. Immediately unplug it from the socket and contact the manufacturer.

SPECIFIC RISKS OF USE

5. Risk of misuse:

- Use a car charger that is compatible with the technical parameters of the vehicle and the device being charged.

6. Hazards associated with a humid environment:

- Do not use the charger in high humidity conditions, e.g. when the car interior is flooded.
- If the charger comes into contact with water, immediately unplug it from the socket and make sure it is dry before using it again.

7. Risk of damage to cables and connectors:

- Avoid excessive bending or stretching of the charger cables, which can lead to damage.
- Regularly check the condition of the connectors and cables. If you notice signs of wear or damage, stop using the device.

8. Damage to the battery of the device being charged:

- Only use chargers with voltage and current regulation that are compatible with the device being charged.
- Do not leave devices charged in the car during extreme temperatures.

9. Extreme temperatures:

- Do not expose the charger to direct sunlight or use it in conditions of extreme cold, which may affect the performance of the device and the safety of use.

MAINTENANCE PRECAUTIONS

10. Cleaning and maintenance:

- Clean the charger with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using water, detergents and sharp tools that may damage the surface of the device.
- Regularly check the condition of the unit, including cables and connectors.

11. Storage of the charger:

- Store the charger in a dry and cool place when not in use. Avoid storing it in a humid environment or in high-temperature areas such as car lockers during hot weather.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

12. Child safety:

- The car charger should be kept out of the reach of children.
- Ensure that children do not have access to the charger or to electronic devices connected to the power source.

13. Disposal:

- Return used or damaged chargers to recycling facilities in accordance with local regulations for the disposal of electronic equipment.

14. Avoid modifications:

- Do not make modifications to the design of the charger, such as changing the power cable or plug, as this may affect its safety, charging efficiency and lead to a risk of damage to the device.

15. Action in the event of an emergency:

- If the unit exhibits abnormal operation, such as overheating, sparking, unusual odour or noises, immediately switch it off and disconnect it from the power supply and then contact the service centre.
- If you observe any unsafe product behaviour, contact the manufacturer urgently.

THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPLYING WITH THE WARNINGS

Following the above warnings minimises the risk of personal injury, equipment failure and property damage. Ignoring the recommendations can lead to serious health and material risks. Keep yourself and your loved ones safe by observing the precautions indicated.
