## **SAFETY WARNINGS FOR USE LAMINATORS**

The following list of safety warnings has been compiled in accordance with the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the misuse of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and way understandable to be accessible to a wide audience, including the elderly and people with reduced mobility.

The laminators on offer from manufacturer NTEC sp. z o.o. are CE certified, which proves their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use laminators according to their intended use and manufacturer's recommendations.

### **BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS**

#### **1. Risk of electric shock:**

- Always plug the laminator into a working earthed socket.
- Do not touch the power cord or plug with wet hands.
- In the event of damage to the power cable, plug or housing of the appliance, stop using it and contact the manufacturer or an authorised service centre.

#### **2. Risk of burns**

- Laminators operate at high temperatures - avoid touching the outlet and heating rollers while the machine is running.
- When you have finished working, leave the unit to cool down before cleaning or storing it.

#### **3. Risk of mechanical damage:**

- Do not put your hands or other objects into the laminator mechanism while it is operating.
- Do not attempt to remove the jammed film without first switching off the unit.

#### **4. Risk of overheating**

- Do not use the appliance for longer than recommended by the manufacturer to prevent overheating.
- Make sure the laminator is standing on a stable, level surface with adequate air access to the vents.

### **SPECIFIC HAZARDS ARISING FROM USE**

#### **5. Hazards in a humid environment:**

- Do not use the laminator in high humidity areas such as bathrooms or near water sources.
- If the appliance is flooded, disconnect it from the power supply and contact an authorised service centre.

#### **6. Hazards at high ambient temperatures:**

- Do not store the laminator in areas exposed to direct sunlight or high temperatures (above 40°C).
- Avoid operating the unit in rooms with extreme temperatures that may affect its performance.

### **MAINTENANCE PRECAUTIONS**

#### **7. Cleaning the device:**

- Unplug the laminator from the power supply and wait for it to cool down before cleaning.

- Use a dry or slightly damp cloth to clean the housing of the machine. Do not apply chemicals or water to the inside of the laminator.

**8. Maintenance of rollers and mechanism:**

- Regularly check the condition of the rollers and remove any residual film only when the appliance is unplugged and cooled down.

**9. Storage**

- Store the laminator in a dry and clean place, away from moisture, dust and extreme temperatures when not in use.

## **ADDITIONAL WARNINGS**

**10. Child safety**

- Keep the laminator out of the reach of children to avoid accidental damage to the machine or cables.

**11. Avoid modifications**

- Do not attempt to modify or repair yourself the laminator . In case of problems, contact the manufacturer's authorised service centre.

**12. Action in the event of an emergency:**

- If the unit exhibits abnormal operation, such as overheating, sparking, unusual odour or noises, immediately switch it off and disconnect it from the power supply and then contact the service centre.
- If you observe any unsafe product behaviour, contact the urgently manufacturer .

## **THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPLYING WITH THE WARNINGS**

Following the above warnings minimises the risk of personal injury, equipment failure and property damage. Ignoring the recommendations can lead to serious health and material risks. Keep yourself and your loved ones safe by observing the precautions indicated.
