SAFETY WARNINGS

Routers and Wi-Fi signal boosters

The following list of safety warnings has been drawn up in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2023/988 on general product safety (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the misuse of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable manner so that they are accessible to a wide audience, including older people and those with reduced mobility.

The routers and Wi-Fi signal boosters offered by NTEC sp. z o.o. are CE-marked, which confirms their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use routers and Wi-Fi signal boosters in accordance with their intended purpose and the manufacturer's instructions.

BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS

1. Risk of overheating:

- The device may generate heat during operation. Incorrect installation or use may lead to overheating, which poses a risk of damage to the device or a fire hazard. Ensure adequate ventilation of the device during operation.
- Do not install near heat sources (e.g. radiators, sunny spots),

2. Risk of physical damage:

- Signal boosters and routers may be susceptible to mechanical damage. Place the device in a stable location, secured against accidental movement or falling.
- Exposure to moisture or extreme temperatures may cause the device to malfunction.
- Please do not dismantle or modify the device yourself.

3. Data security risks:

- A lack of adequate Wi-Fi security (e.g. using weak passwords or no encryption) may expose the user to hacking attacks.
- Using public Wi-Fi networks without additional security measures, such as a VPN, may lead to data interception.

SPECIFIC RISKS ARISING FROM USE

4. Risks associated with installation:

- Incorrect installation of the device may lead to malfunction, reduced performance, and pose a risk of electrical hazards or overheating.

5. Signal quality management:

- Signal interference caused by the presence of other wireless devices (e.g. microwaves, DECT phones) may reduce connection quality.

6. Compatibility risks:

- Use devices operating in the same frequency bands (2.4 GHz / 5 GHz).
- Incompatibility may result in reduced transmission speeds, connection instability or the inability to configure the device correctly.

7. Risks associated with software updates:

- Failure to install regular software updates may lead to compatibility and security issues.

8. Risks associated with use in environments with high network traffic:

- In networks with a large number of users (e.g. in offices, halls of residence), the device may struggle to maintain a stable connection.
- Low network bandwidth may limit data transfer speeds.

9. Risks associated with network configuration:

- Incorrect configuration (e.g. selecting the wrong Wi-Fi channel) may reduce connection performance.

- Use with networks employing different security standards (e.g. WPA3 vs. WPA2) may cause connectivity issues.

10. Risks arising from improper use:

- Connecting the router to damaged or contaminated USB ports may cause it to fail.

PRECAUTIONS DURING MAINTENANCE

11. Cleaning:

- Regularly remove dust and dirt from the surface using a dry cloth or compressed air. Do not use chemicals or solvents. Disconnect the device from the power supply before cleaning.

12. Condition check:

- Check the condition of the connections regularly.

13. Storage:

- When not in use, store the product in a dry place, away from moisture and dust.

ADDITIONAL WARNINGS

14. Child safety:

- Keep out of reach of children to prevent accidental damage or injury.

15. Avoid modifications:

- Do not attempt to modify or open the casing yourself, as this could affect the stability or durability of the product.

16. What to do in the event of a fault:

- If the product exhibits any abnormal behaviour, such as an unusual smell, appearance or noise, stop using it immediately and contact customer service.
- If you observe any dangerous behaviour of the product, contact the manufacturer urgently.
