## **SAFETY WARNINGS FOR USE CODE LOCKS AND CARD AND KEY RING READERS**

The following list of safety warnings has been compiled in accordance with the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR). Its purpose is to protect users from potential hazards arising from the misuse of products. The warnings have been formulated in a simple and understandable way to be accessible to a wide audience, including the elderly and people with reduced mobility.

The code locks and card and key ring readers on offer from manufacturer NTEC sp. z o.o. are CE certified, which proves their compliance with EU safety standards.

Use code locks and card and key fob readers in accordance with their intended use and manufacturer's recommendations.

### **BASIC HAZARDS AND PRECAUTIONS**

#### **1. Risk of electric shock**

- Leave the installation of the code lock, card reader or key fob to a qualified technician.
- Avoid touching electrical wires during installation or maintenance.
- If you notice any damage to the cables or other electrical components, immediately disconnect the unit from the power supply and contact a service centre.

#### **2. Risk of overheating**

- Do not install equipment in direct sunlight or near heat sources (e.g. radiators).
- Make sure the equipment has adequate ventilation and is not obstructed.

#### **3. Risk of physical injury:**

- When assembling equipment, use appropriate tools and wear protective gloves to prevent cuts.
- Ensure that all mounting components, such as screws, are properly tightened and secured.

#### **4. Cyber security risks:**

- Use strong and unique access codes and store authorisation data securely.
- Do not share authorisation data with unauthorised persons.

### **SPECIFIC HAZARDS ARISING FROM USE**

#### **5. Safety for use in humid environments:**

- Devices intended for outdoor use, such as combination locks, have a corresponding degree of protection, namely IP68, providing resistance to moisture, rain and dust.
- Avoid installing card and key fob readers in areas with permanent contact with water, e.g. outdoor terraces without a cover.

#### **6. Precautions at low temperatures:**

- Make sure the equipment is suitable for low temperatures, such details can be found in the specifications of each device
- If the appliance freezes, avoid using force - use suitable defrosting agents and contact an authorised service centre

#### **7. Precautions at high temperatures:**

- Do not install equipment in areas where the temperature may exceed the manufacturer's specified range (e.g. near glass subjected to intense sunlight).

### **MAINTENANCE PRECAUTIONS**

#### **1. Cleaning the device:**

- Use only a soft cloth to clean the equipment, avoid using irritating cleaners that may damage the equipment.
- 2. State maintenance:**
    - Regularly check the condition of equipment, including its electronic mechanisms.
  - 3. Storage of the device:**
    - When not in use, store the combination lock or card and key fob reader in its original packaging or in a protective case to avoid mechanical damage.

#### **ADDITIONAL WARNINGS**

- 4. Avoid modifications**
  - Do not modify the devices or their components, as this may affect their performance and violate the manufacturer's warranty.
  - Always follow the operating instructions provided by the manufacturer.
  - If you have any doubts about the operation of the equipment, contact the service department or the manufacturer.
- 5. Action in the event of an emergency:**
  - If the unit exhibits abnormal operation, such as overheating, sparking, unusual odour or noises, immediately switch it off and disconnect it from the power supply and then contact the service centre.
  - If you observe any unsafe product behaviour, contact the manufacturer urgently.

#### **THE IMPORTANCE OF COMPLYING WITH THE WARNINGS**

Following the above warnings minimises the risk of personal injury, equipment failure and property damage. Ignoring the recommendations can lead to serious health and material risks. Keep yourself and your loved ones safe by observing the precautions indicated.
